With reference to our telephonic conversation, we propose to conduct a joint webinar on 23 September 2022 on the topic of Resource Efficiency in Educational Campuses.

CSE launched its Green Campus Initiative in 2017. Since then, a national network of campuses has been engaged time and again to transform educational campuses into sustainable, resource prudent and less wasteful habitats. CSE also has an ongoing engagement on the subject with Punjab Pollution Control Board and have recently been engaged in helping them with creating green guidelines for offices.

Several publications by CSE have captured the best green practices by educational campuses in the past.
