GUIDELINES:

- 1. Annual income of the parents/guardian from all sources of the SC/ST students should not exceeded to Rs. 3.00 lacs. In case father/guardian is an employee, annual income certificate from employer be attached. in other cases, income certificate be attached. (By the Ist class Magistrate).
- 2. Any candidates who either failed or could not clear 50 % of the papers in the previous examination as on date of application would be not eligible for this financial assistance.
- 3. Financial Assistance to be given for 9 months, as is being done in the case of Government Scholarships, directly into the bank account of student.
- 4. Rs. 2000/- be given as an incentive (one time) to those SC/ST students, who have secured 65% marks or more and Rs. 1500/- to those SC/ST students who secured 55% to 64.99 % marks in the previous examination.

Activities, aims & objectives of SC/ST Cell:-

<u>Activities:</u> The SC/ST cell of Panjab University is presently located in Aruna Ranjit Chandra Hall, Ist floor, Room No. 216, Near Post office, Panjab University. Presently, SC/ST cell is functioning with the help of Co-ordinator (Professor), Office Supt, one Clerk and one Sr.Asstt. and one peon.

- 1. The main **objective** of the SC/ST cells is to implement, monitor and evaluate continuously the reservation policy of Governance of India and to comply with UGC regulation.
- 2. SC/ST cell is instrumental in following the various welfare policies and programmes of Govt of India for students, teachers and non teaching community of Panjab University.
- 3. SC/ST cell is also effectively implementing the policies/welfare schemes in respect of admission of SC/ST students, appointment to teaching, non teaching position in the University and in the affiliating colleges.

Scholarships being dealt with by SC/ST Cell:-

- 1. Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship for OBC Students by the Govt of India/State Govt/U.T. Admn. Studies in India:- Those candidates belonging to OBCs so specified in relation to the State/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs, i.e. is permanently settled, who have passed the Matriculation or higher secondary or any higher examination of a recognized university or Board of Secondary Education and who belong to a family having income not exceeding Rs. 1 lac per annum are eligible
- 2. Financial Assistance to students for SC/ST categories:- under the budget head "Impetus to Research" for providing Subsidy/Grant/Assistance to students of SC/ST categories and income criteria for grant of Financial Assistance to SC/ST student of the teaching departments of Panjab University is Rs. 2.50 lac.(Income limit Rs. 2.50 lac) & other formalities like Post Matric Scholarship.

3. Post Matric Scholarship Scheme of the Govt. of Punjab:-

1. **For Normal Courses**: The students belonging to the Scheduled Castes whose parents/guardian are the permanent residents of Punjab State and are studying in any recognized college in any part of India are entitled for scholarship, provided that the yearly income of their parents/guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs. 2,50,000 & tution fee & other non-refundable charges be not taken from the SC students belonging to Punjab State at the time of admission for various courses other

than self-financing courses of the Panjab University and its Regional Centres from the Session 2009-2010.

- 2. For Self-Financing Courses:-: The students belonging to the Scheduled Castes whose parents/guardian are the permanent residents of Punjab State and are studying in any recognized college in any part of India are entitled for scholarship, provided that the yearly income of their parents/guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/-, must deposit only 25% of the fee of the respective semester at the time of admission.
- 4. **Post Matric Scholarship Scheme of the Govt. of India:**Only those candidates who belong to Schedules Castes so specified in relation to the State/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs i.e. permanently settled and who have passed the Matriculation or Higher Secondary or any examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible provided that the yearly income of their parents/guardian from all sources should not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/-.

To Collect the Statistical Information: The SC/ST Cell is also collecting the Statistical Information related to Teaching and Nonteaching staff, and students admitted in all courses during each academic session and Number of students admitted in Hostels for further transmission of consolidated data to UGC, New Delhi every year.

Reservation in Admission:- The Panjab University is giving Reservation in Admission as per following rule:-

- 1. That as per Regulation 29.1(C) contained in chapter VIII(D) "ADMISSION AND MIGRATION OF STUDENTS AND TUTION FEES' at page 168 of Panjab University Calendar Vol.I, 2007, All University Teaching Departments shall follow the reservation policy which is as under:
 - (a) 15% for candidate belonging to the Scheduled Caste.
 - (b) 7.5% for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes.
 - (c) 5% for candidates belonging to the Backward classes

Provided that the reservation (a) and (b) can be interchangeable i.e. if a sufficient number of applicants is not available to fill up the seats reserved for Scheduled Tribes, they may be fill up by suitable candidates from Scheduled Castes, and vice-versa.

The above reservation shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The number of students admitted on merit shall not be included in the number of seats reserved.
- (ii) Members of Scheduled Castes/Tribes and Backward Classes shall be allowed a concession of 5% marks for admission to the courses in which a certain percentage of minimum marks has been prescribed provided they have obtained minimum pass marks prescribed by regulations;
- (iii) case the seats earmarked for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes remain unfilled, a further relaxation in marks may be given, in order of merit inter-se amongst the candidates themselves, so that all the reserved seats are filled by candidates belonging to these categories. This, however, will not apply for M.B.B.S. admission; and
- (iv) A Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe person on migration from the State of his origin will not lose his status as Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe but he will be entitled to the concessions/benefits admissible to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes from the State of his origin and not from the State where he has migrated.

2. Reservation in appointments in Teaching & Non-Teaching Posts:-

The Panjab University is giving reservation in appointments in Teaching as per UGC regulation-2006. However, reservation in Non-Teaching posts is being given as per the Rule at pages 77-78 of Panjab University Calendar Volume III, 2009. Supporting documents are enclosed for further information.

Thus, it is clear these provisions for reservations in **appointments** to all teaching and non-teaching posts and for admission of students to various teaching departments are already there in the Act/Statutes of Panjab University, as per UGC guidelines.

Reservation Policy in Hostel Accommodation:-The Panjab University, Chandigarh is giving 15% reservation to SC and 7.5% reservation to ST in the hostel accommodation and Room rent is not levied from the SC/ST students.

Panjab University is following reservation policy of Govt. of India in the recruitment of teachers as under:-

- (i) Schedule Caste -15%
- (ii) Schedule Tribe-7.5%
- (iii) Physically Disabled-3%

Whereas in the recruitment of non-teaching employees the reservation is as under:-

- (i) Schedule Caste -15%
- (ii) Schedule Tribe-5%
- (iii) Backward Class-2.5%
