Subject: Launch of the electronic version of the Supreme Court Reports (e-SCR).

Sir,

I am directed to refer you on the subject cited above and to inform you that Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has launched the electronic version of the Supreme Court Reports (e-SCR), wherein e-SCR will facilitate access to the judgments of the Supreme Court, free of subscription without any other expense for the user. The database of e-SCR contains at present about 34,000 reported judgments of the Supreme Court and the search facility in e-SCR provides for free text search, search, within search, case type and case year search, judge search, year and volume search and bench strength search options. The access link/tab of e-SCR has been provided on the Supreme Court website, in the mobile application of the Supreme Court and at the judgment portal of the eCourts project (<https://judgments.ecourts.gov.in>) and on the website of this Court (<https://highcourtchd.gov.in/>)

You are, therefore, requested to disseminate this information amongst the respective District Bar Associations, law colleges and education institutions for effectively availing the facility of e-SCR.
