Respected Madam/Sir,

As you are aware the National Education Policy 2020 emphasizes the creation of motivated, energized, and capable faculty. The capacity building of the faculty at all levels has been one of the major thrust areas in the field of Higher Education. Existing mechanisms for capacity building of faculty, i.e. UGC-Human Resource Development Centres (HRDCs) and Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) Centres are contributing immensely towards training faculty of Higher Education Institutions to provide more effective teaching. However, continuous professional development of faculty in all disciplines is required in light of new and updated methods of pedagogy.

Keeping in view the optimal utilization of infrastructure, and human and financial resources the Ministry of Education (MoE) has sought synergy and integration between HRDCs and PMMNMTT. Centres to be strengthened to meet the objective of NEP-2020. In this regard, the Hon'ble Minister for Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan ji launched the Malaviya Mission-Teacher Training Programme (MM-TTP) on the occasion of Teachers' Day on 5th September 2023. He also launched the MM-TTP portal (https://mmc.ugc.ac.in) and released an information brochure on MM-TTP.(enclosed). 111 institutions have been identified as a part of the programme which will now be called Malaviva Mission Teacher Training Centres (MMTTC).(list attached)

The main objective of the new phase of the scheme is the Orientation and Sensitization of the Faculty members of HEIs on core NEP 2020 Themes (list enclosed). The programme aims at improving the quality of Education at all levels by infusing quality and excellence in our teachers and teaching. The Malaviya Mission Training Programme shall be taken into consideration for the fulfilment of the requirements as laid down in the Career Advancement Scheme of UGC.

I take this opportunity to request all HEIs to encourage faculty members from their institution to take part in the MM-TTP by nominating them to register for online training on the Malayiva Mission Portal (https://mmc.ugc.ac.in). The link to Malaviva Mission Portal may also be provided on your Institution's website.

We look forward to the active participation of faculty members from your respective HEI in the Malayiya Mission Teacher Training programme.
