

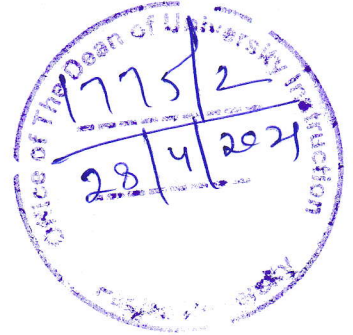

1. Mandatory prior registration at cowin.gov.in for first/second dose of vaccine. Registration will start from 28th April 2021. Steps for registration of vaccination is attached herewith (copy attached). Unregistered persons will not be able to get the vaccine without prior registration.
2. Preference for vaccination will be given to those whose 2nd dose is due.
3. 2nd beneficiaries will be 45 and above.
4. People as on 1st Jan 2022 who are in the age group of 18-44 will be third beneficiaries and they also require prior registration.
5. Anticipating panic rush for vaccination, all employees/retirees/students are requested to cooperate in maintaining social distancing, using face mask.
6. Anticipating a rush, we will be issuing token for a set of twenty people every hour.
7. You are requested to bring your Aadhar Card and one more ID such as PAN card/voter ID card/driving license.
8. Second dose of vaccine is to be taken after 6 to 8 weeks of 1st dose with prior registration.
9. People who have been detected Covid positive before or after the 1st dose of vaccine need to get the second vaccination after 8 weeks of recovery.
10. As per the Govt. of India guidelines vaccine is safe for the girls and would be mothers.
11. However, for vaccination of pregnant and lactating mothers, is the decision of their treating Gynaecologist/ family.
12. Immunity will not develop immediately after covid vaccine. Tentative immunity will develop after 4 to 6 weeks of 2nd dose of vaccination.

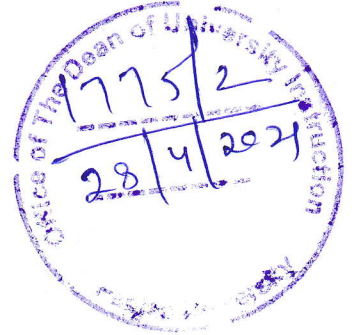
